



## CURRENCY DECLARATION FORM

[See Regulation 3(1)] — Foreign Exchange Declaration on Arrival in India

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PASSENGERS

- This form need NOT be completed if the aggregate foreign exchange (currency notes, bank notes, travellers' cheques) does NOT exceed US \$10,000 or equivalent AND the foreign currency notes do NOT exceed US \$5,000 or equivalent.
1. Produce this form to an authorised bank/money changer at the time of conversion.
  2. Visitors who do not wish to encash all foreign exchange should retain this form for production to Customs at the time of departure to take unutilised balance.
  3. Details of travellers' cheques or currency notes need not be furnished separately.
  4. Foreign tourists need not indicate their address.
